Framework for developing the e Learning Material:

- Each 3 credit paper of B.Ed. Program is divided into 4 Units having 4 topics each. This whole syllabus is divided into 40 topics, 10 topics in each unit. Each paper will have 4 formative assessments 1 after each unit and 1 summative assessment at the end of whole paper.
- The topics will be shared in google sheet. Techer Educators will be required to select a topic of choice. They may select one or more than one topic.

Guidelines for Authors

1. The topic selection is to be made in the prescribed format shared by IITE. Each topic covers one point of the given unit.
2. The author can select any number of topics from the given list but the author for the given topic should be single.
3. The language of submission (audio video and text) can be Gujarati/ Hindi/English
4. The e content for the given topic is to be provided in the four quadrants:
 - a. Video Lecture of 30-40 min.
 - b. PPT covering the topic/ or pdf with self-learning material with reading time of 20-30 min.
 - c. A word file of references having active links with study time of 20-30 min.
 - d. Assessment questionnaire of 20 min.

Thus each topic will be covered in about 120 min. that is 2 hrs.

5. The content of the 4 quadrants should be provided in the given format only with a good quality resolution in case of video and appropriate formatting and settings in case of power point, pdf and word file.
6. The video, ppt. and pdf should describe the Learning objectives and the outcomes. There should be a brief summary at the end.
7. The content developed should be authentic and without copying and/ or paraphrasing from the existing content. The author will be solely responsible for the plagiarism and copyright issues.
8. The content should be of good quality, updated and relevant to the context and the topic. Care should be taken for the language used, images projected and examples cited to avoid any controversy or hurt any feelings.
9. The nominations once called for will be reviewed by a review committee and their decision will be final regarding the selection of e content developer. The content submitted by the author will be duly reviewed by the committee and they may request the revision in the content to the author.
10. The last date for selection of title is 15th ~~October 2021~~ **JANUARY 2022**
