On the 6th day of October, 2016 Dr. Prerana H. Shelat and Dr. Sheetal M. Helaiya were appointed as the NSS Programme officers of 2 units of IITE, Gandhinagar. The two units of NSS at IITE Gandhinagar are already in existence since 2014-15. Then after during academic year 2016-17 new entrants of First Year Bachelor degree were enrolled on 22nd of October, 2016.

1) **ETI Training**

It is the mandatory requirement for NSS Programmer Officers to attend ETI training within three months of their appointment as per the guidelines given by Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports under NSS scheme. Both the programme officers attended ETI training during 5th of January, 2017 to 11th of January, 2017 at Gujarat Vidyapeeth, Ahmedabad. Based on the deliberations during the ETI training and interaction with the experts both the officers had a brain storming session and came out with the certain activities which they proposed to be carried out at IITE to the Honourable Vice Chancellor vide a letter dated 16th of February, 2017.

2) **Orientation to NSS Volunteers**

On 22nd of March, 2017, orientation to NSS Volunteers was organised. The orientation was done by the NSS Programme Officers. In the orientation, they were oriented about the importance of NSS, its motto meaning and importance of NSS logo, NSS song and NSS clap. They were also oriented regarding various activities that can be carried out under the NSS cell of the university for the welfare of the society. They have listed and proposed various activities which can be carried out in the society as part of social responsibility towards the Nation.

As the examinations were approaching in the month of April there was paucity of time and therefore only one activity was conducted during year 2016-17.

3) **Blood Donation Camp**

NSS cell of IITE has organised Blood Donation Camp with the help of Government GMERS Medical College & Civil Hospital of Gandhinagar. It was scheduled on 24th of March, 2017 between 9:00 am and 1:00 pm. 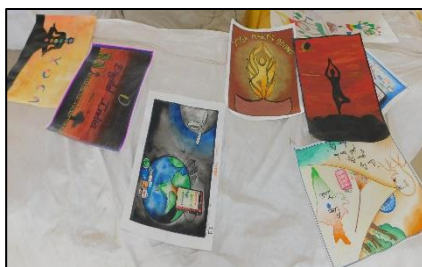
2) **Participation in NSS Day Celebration at KSKV University, Bhuj**

During academic year 2018-2019, total 152 students have registered as NSS volunteers. Out of 152 NSS Volunteers, 48 are male and 104 are female students.

1) Orientation to NSS Volunteers

In the beginning of the academic year 2018-2019, first year B.Sc. B.Ed. and B.A. B.Ed. students were oriented regarding National Service Scheme (NSS) and their enrolment as NSS volunteers was carried out.

2) Awareness programme under Swachh Bharat Summer Internship-2018

Under national scheme Swachh Bharat Summer Internship-2018, total 13 students have register themselves under two mentors. Total 100 hours were spent by the NSS volunteers at Mota Koba village of Gandhinagar district to create awareness regarding swachhta. At Mota Koba village various activities were carried out by the NSS volunteers in which apart from registered NSS volunteers many NSS volunteers have voluntarily participated. They have organised various activities such as

i) Door to door visit

In the selected village, NSS volunteers initiated with objective to sensitize people regarding cleanliness and its impact on our health. This activity was planned to find out their awareness regarding swachhta and how they maintain hygiene at their home and the surrounding. NSS volunteers visited each home in the village and interacted with

the people of the village. They have also observed the cleanliness and hygiene maintained by them near their home surrounding and the surrounding of the village.

ii) **Cleanly activity**

As per the observation and interaction with people of the village, NSS volunteers decided to first sensitize students regarding the cleanliness. With the prior permission and support of the elementary school teachers and students, they cleaned the government elementary school and its surrounding with the help of school students. The school students have actively participated. They also promise to maintain cleanliness at their home and in their village.

To bring out creativity of the students and how waste material can be recycled, at the school, competition of making best out of wastage, Poster-making and essay writing were organised for 6th to 8th standard students in which as per their interest student took part.

iii) **Wastage Management**

To create awareness regarding recycling waste materials (degradable and non-degradable waste materials), NSS volunteers have shown short film projecting effect of wastage created by human being on the environment, ways through which such waste material can be recycled. Based on film shown discussion was carried out with the students and students also shared how they can recycle waste materials.

iv) Swachhta Awareness Rally:

With motto to create more awareness regarding swachhta among the people of the village. The NSS volunteers have organised swachhta awareness rally with the help of school students. In the morning time, NSS volunteers and students have started swachhta awareness rally by chanting near “1 2 3 4 kachara fekna atyachar,..... bandh karo ye atyachar” and visited each street of the village. For the rally they have prepared banner with slogan on cleanliness and importance of hygiene with the help of school students.

v) Health and Hygiene awareness programme for girls

To create awareness regarding health and hygiene among girls of standard 7th and 8th, health and hygiene awareness programme was organised by the NSS girl volunteers. In this programme, they took session to make elementary girl students aware regarding menstruation and myths related to it prevailing in the society. NSS girl volunteers have shown video related to how to maintain hygiene during menstruation followed by the discussion regarding what care girl has to take during this period.

vi) **Street Play on Swachhta**

To create awareness reading swachhta, NSS volunteers have prepared street play in gujarati language. They have performed it in the village streets. Through the play they tried to convey message that every individual is responsible for the polluting the earth and its everyone moral responsibility to make maintain cleanliness.

4) **NSS Day Celebration 2018**

Out of two NSS volunteers of IITE, Ms. Drasti Padalia was selected as one of the Gujarat state representatives. She has attended PRD training at training along with other NSS volunteers from Gujarat state. There were total 52 NSS volunteers were selected from Gujrat state for PRD training at Nagpur. She took 25 days training at Nagpur from 25th of November, 2018 to 04th December,2018 and got selected to represent Gujarat state at national level. 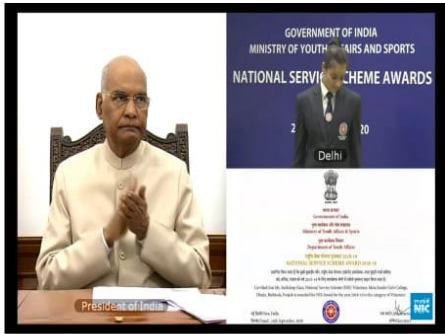

1) Orientation of NSS for CoE students

To introduce the National Service Scheme (NSS) cell of the University and college level to the students of IITE, Program Coordinator Ms. Darshana Likhada has conducted one session in the assembly of CoE on 26/09/2020. 2) Enrolment of NSS Volunteers

3) Road Safety Survey Activity

With reference to the letter No. GUJROSA/Awareness/423 dated 16/10/2020 from the Road Safety Commissioner Shree L. P. Padalia for 'awareness and road safety education to be imparted to the students of the colleges/University', a small survey was held online by NSS cell among students and faculty members of IITE. A large number of people have willingly participated in this survey. The main aim of this survey was to know how many are holding valid driving license, following traffic rules, wearing safety gears, etc. as mentioned in the referred letter. A brief analysis of this survey includes the points like; more number of females have responded than males, average age of participant is 21 years, the majority possess valid driving license, also follows the traffic rules like over speeding, wrong side driving, red light jumping, and wear safety gears like helmet or seat belt. It is also noticed in the responses that a lack of awareness of driver is more responsible for road accidents according to the participants. It was also asked if they have any strategy for traffic management, almost everyone has written their thoughts very nicely. It mainly includes, the traffic rules, speed limit criteria should be followed strictly, road maintenance, intelligent traffic signals installation, a subject on road safety and awareness should be included in higher secondary studies, etc.

The report of the same was also sent to the Road Safety Commissioner on 06/11/2020.

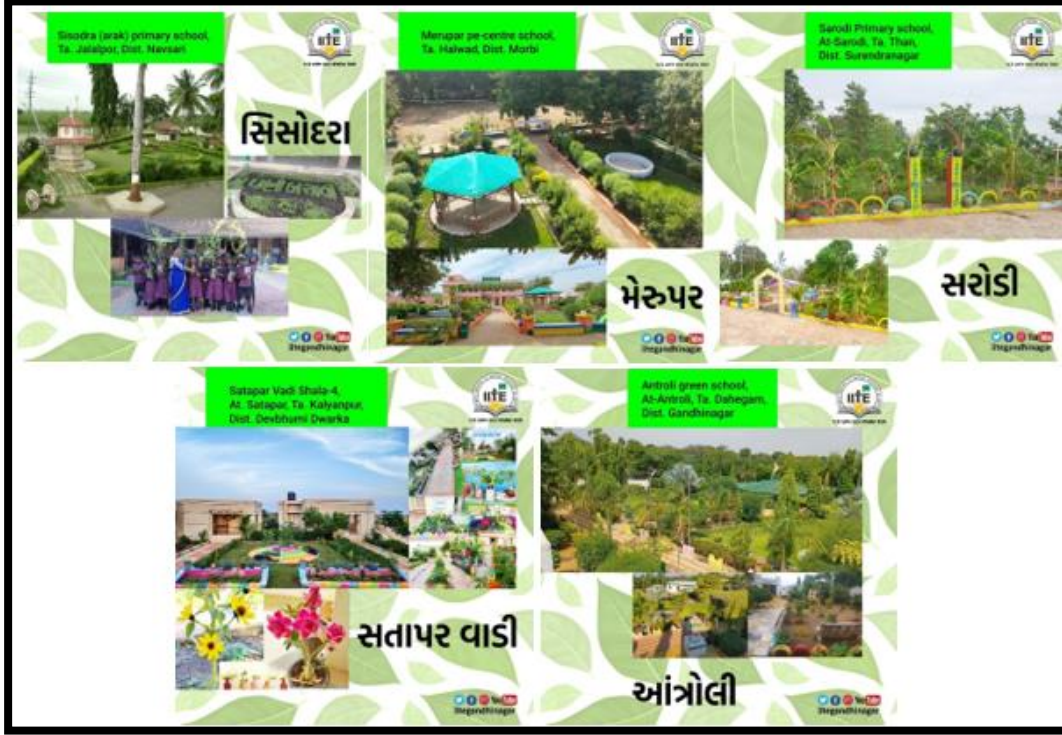

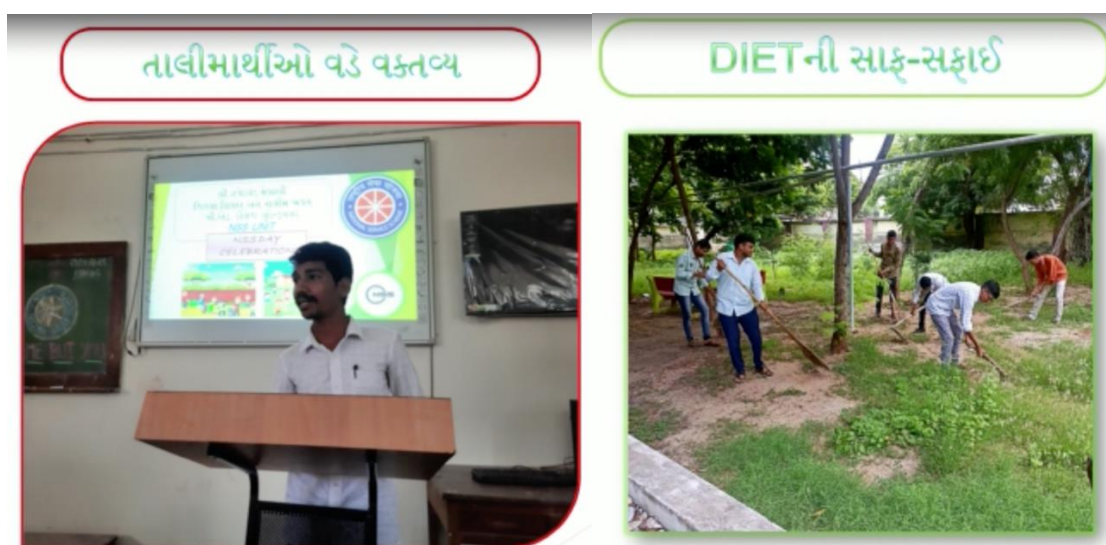
