



### 6. SWACHH BHARAT ABHIYAAN

In 2018 May, the Government of India launched the 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyaan' throughout the nation. All the educational institutions and NCC groups across India were given instructions and guidelines to conduct a 'Swachh Bharat Summer Internship'. As a part of the project the NCC Cadets of IITE also carried out the project in various phases as follows:



## 7. Planning and Preparation for the 'Abhiyaan'

Discussions and planning as to how the whole project will be carried out, which village can be adopted to carry out and spread the 'Swachh Bharat' campaign were carried out initially.

All 33 NCC cadets and ANO, Lt. Dr. Swarnabharati of IITE actively participated not only in the planning and preparation sessions but also carried out all the activities enthusiastically.



## 8. Adopting a Village – Nana Chiloda

As a part of the ‘Swachh Bharat Summer Internship’ the NCC cadets of IITE were required to adopt a village to spread awareness about importance of cleanliness, hygiene and sanitation. The NCC Cadets were required to spread the awareness through various activities like door to door visit to spread awareness, street play, rally, cleaning the village/village school and spreading awareness among students.

Nana Chiloda Village was selected for this purpose and we met the Sarpanch of Nana Chiloda village for permission to carry out these activities in the village over a period of a week.

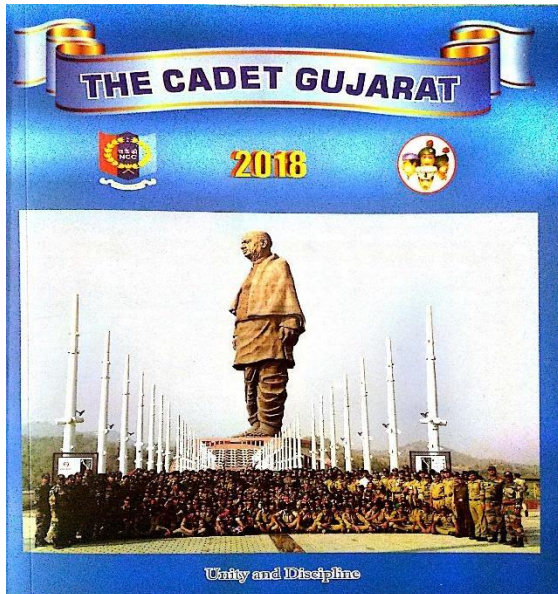






## 20. The Cadet Gujarat Magazine (2018)

### PRCN COURSE: FROM THE DIARY OF AN ANO

#### Selection

When I joined the Indian Institute of Teacher Education, Gandhinagar, the NCC Girls battalion was on the verge of suspension for the want of an ANO. As no other faculty showed interest in taking up the responsibility, I accepted it as an opportunity to fulfil my dream of becoming an Army Officer, and as I had been an NCC cadet, I felt I would be able to do justice to the role. I was appointed as an Associate NCC Officer under Direct Commission on 10<sup>th</sup> November, 2016. As per the requirement of the post, I was directed to attend the 3-month PRCN Training Course at Gwalior. I was granted On Duty leave to attend the DG/SW – 71 Course conducted from 14 Aug 2017 to 11 Nov 2017 at Officers' Training Academy, Gwalior.

#### First Day in OTA, Gwalior

As per directions received from the Academy, I reached OTA on 13<sup>th</sup> Aug, 2017. I was allotted a room to be shared by three other trainees. In the evening, on the same day, we were given instructions regarding the next day's training schedule, which began with Physical Training at 5.30 a.m. followed by Drill training from 7.15 to 8.10 a.m. After breakfast we were directed to be seated in Sam Manekshaw Hall, where the Training Officer/Coordination welcomed us and spelled out the rules and regulations of the Academy and the code of conduct expected from the trainees. We were also introduced to the other officers and trainees in the Academy who would not only conduct our training, but would also be taking care of our needs during our three-months stay in the Academy. After three days of the commencement of the course, the Commandant of OTA Gwalior addressed the trainees and welcomed all for the three months training and stay at OTA.



After the tea-break at 4.20 p.m., personality development activities were conducted which helped us reinforce our team-building, coordination and unity, and problem-solving skills. The personality development activities were followed by games hour, where each one of us had to competently play any game or at least learn from others who knew some game (we

were not allowed to sit idle, gossip, do any other work or wander, least of all go back to our room). I tried my hand at throw ball, volley ball, badminton and basket ball (at least learnt to play, if not become a pro). It was fun as I got an opportunity to make friends, who were sports persons, both literally and figuratively. At 6.20 p.m. we were allowed to go to our rooms to freshen up for fall-in at 7.30 p.m., when instructions for the next day were given followed by dinner at 8.00 p.m.

This remained the daily schedule of training at the Academy, we were taught various subjects like Personality Development, Character Building and Communication Skills, Map Reading, First Aid, National Integration, General Awareness in topics like Disaster Management, Child Sexual Abuse, Rights and Duties as a Citizen, Natural calamities, Setting up a Camp, Camp Management, Weapon Training, etc.

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and probably in our work as officers and leaders. As trainees were required to fall-in at 5.15 a.m. for PT, waking up at 4.00 a.m. was inevitable to get ready for the same. By the time the classes started at 8.00 a.m., comfortably seated in the AC hall (August, September and October were heavily hot in Gwalior), we trainees would be torridly sleepy due to fatigue and lack of enough sleep, and the Officer (OTA Commandant) was a terror for anyone who dozed off. I enjoyed in his classes questioning, debating and discussing every topic he taught. I graduated from 31 (my trainee number) to "Avni" (derived from my surname "Evani", as my name is always difficult to remember, by virtue of its length and novelty, for many) in his classes.



The Commandant was well-impregnated with my classroom discussions, presentations and overall code of conduct and chose me to be the opening speaker in front of DG NCC Lt. Gen. Vinod Vashisth, who visited OTA on 16<sup>th</sup> September, 2017; and to be the voice of OTA in a video recording to introduce the project Yuva Shakti for the future courses. I was very happy, especially when the DG NCC appreciated my speech, diction and style of presenting; he said "You make your presence felt".



#### Mid Term Break

In the two days mid-term break, I along with some of my fellow trainees spent time sight-seeing in Gwalior which was a wonderful experience. By now OTA had become a second home and all the trainees' one big family. The second term began with more rigorous drill training both, in morning and in evening, as we had to prepare for the Practical exam-Drill Square test (DST) as well as the Passing out Parade.

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#### Exercises

Various projects, like 'Exercise' - 'Anuthav', where we were taught to plan institutional training for our NCC cadets; 'Exercise' - 'Sankalp' in which the trainees were required to understand the Aims, Mission and Vision of NCC, brainstorm, and come up with some activities they would carry out in their institutions to make their cadets understand the same was taught; 'Exercise' - 'Shakti', in which camp planning and its conduct was taught; 'Exercise' - 'Yuva Shakti' wherein planning and execution of various Community and Social Service activities were taught. These were also conducted as group tasks with untenable deadlines, which gave us all sleepless nights.



These Exercises were also a part of competitions. I have been awarded the Commandant's Certificate for Excellence in Planning of Character Development for Exercise 'Sankalp', Commandant's Certificate for Excellence in Camp Planning for Exercise 'Shakti' and the Commandant's Certificate for Excellence in Lecture.

An important integral part of NCC training for cadets is developing a strong character and personality. 'Exercise' - 'Sankalp' was a project in which we were required to come up with activities and ideas for character building in day-to-day life of our cadets.

As a part of the 'Exercise' - 'Shakti' I was appointed the Deputy Camp Commandant of the camp which was set up and run entirely by the trainees.

Each of the Exercises - Anuthav (planning Annual Institutional Training), Sankalp (understanding the Aims, Vision and Mission of NCC), Shakti (planning and conducting a Camp) and Yuva Shakti (planning and conducting Community Development and Social Awareness activities) was a group task; we were allotted different groups for each Awareness activities) and at no given point of time we were interacting with the same trainees. Ego tussles and politics are always a part and parcel of the process of growing and becoming friends, and all this spiced up our three month journey.

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### Camp

Planning a camp, its layout and every nuance of its administration was taught practically, through 'Exercise Shakti'. We actually spent a whole day on field, cleaning up the ground, digging snake pits and pitching tents; heavy duty strenuous physical activity, as a result of best part of the exercise was living in the tents we pitched overnight in the chilling November cold! We cooked lunch, which was savoured by officers, trainers, including the Commandant, which was an honour for all of us (trainees).



I was made the Deputy Camp Commandant, who had to execute duties like the overall security of the camp, planning the training schedule and supervising its correct and timely execution, et al, which was fun, and I was also appreciated for the meticulous execution of my duties. This of course was not possible without the co-operation and motivation of fellow trainees. The training was showing its effect on all the trainees; we were not only re-learning importance of working as a team, negotiating, resolving conflicts and problem-solving collectively, which we were required to inculcate in our cadets back home; but also, the integrity, conviction and toughness required to be an officer.



Various competitions were also held as a part of the 3-month training program. All the 93 trainees were divided into 2 companies – Alpha and Bravo. I was a part of the Alpha Company. Competitions in various Games, Drill, Lecture IP, Yoga, Map Reading, Camp Layout, etc were conducted between the two companies.

### Moments to Cherish

It was the vision of the DG NCC that all NCC cadets should develop confidence to face an audience and speak on any topic, as a part of this, Lecture IP was made compulsory for all the ANOs and competition was held for the same. Overall it was a challenging yet a learning experience, which gave me an opportunity to live the regimented Army life I always dreamed of.



The terror called final exam, and the prestigious 'Passing Out Parade' were looming on our heads in the final week of our 3-month training, which all of us overcame successfully. The moment when each one of the trainees was piped was perhaps an ecstatic one; the realization that we survived the onerous 3-month training and have finally become officers was incredible!

No trainees belonging to the same state were allowed to stay in the same room, as NCC means National Integration. Understandably, each one of us had friends from the same battalion or state or region attending the course, who wanted to be together always and we were not allowed to do so. Slowly, as time passed, all got acquainted with each other. One of our Personality Development activities was telling the name of as many trainees we knew on their face!

On 11<sup>th</sup> November, 2017, after the Passing out Parade and Oath ceremony, the Officer Training Coordination, congratulated us for successfully completing the training and becoming officers. Happy that we passed, made new friends across India, ecstatic that we were finally officers, and the most important of all, that we were returning home, all parted ways.

For me, it was a lifetime experience, a dream which would have never been realized if I had not been a part of the Indian Institute of Teacher Education, Gandhinagar.

### 23. Adventure Sports Camp – Parasailing (11<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> February 2019)

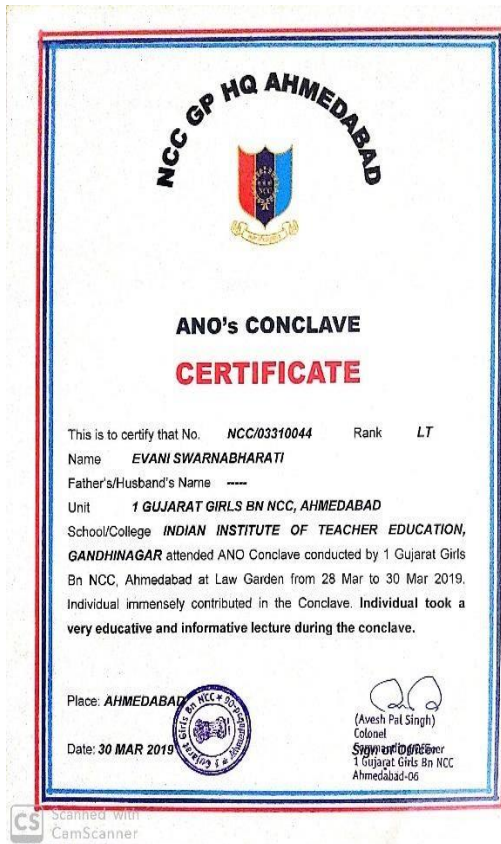

### 31. Visit by the Commanding Officer (July 2019)

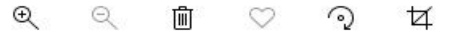

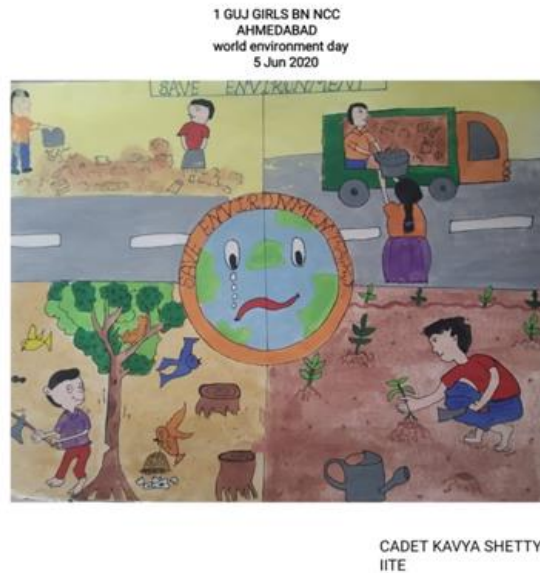
### 38. International Yoga Day (21<sup>st</sup> June 2020)

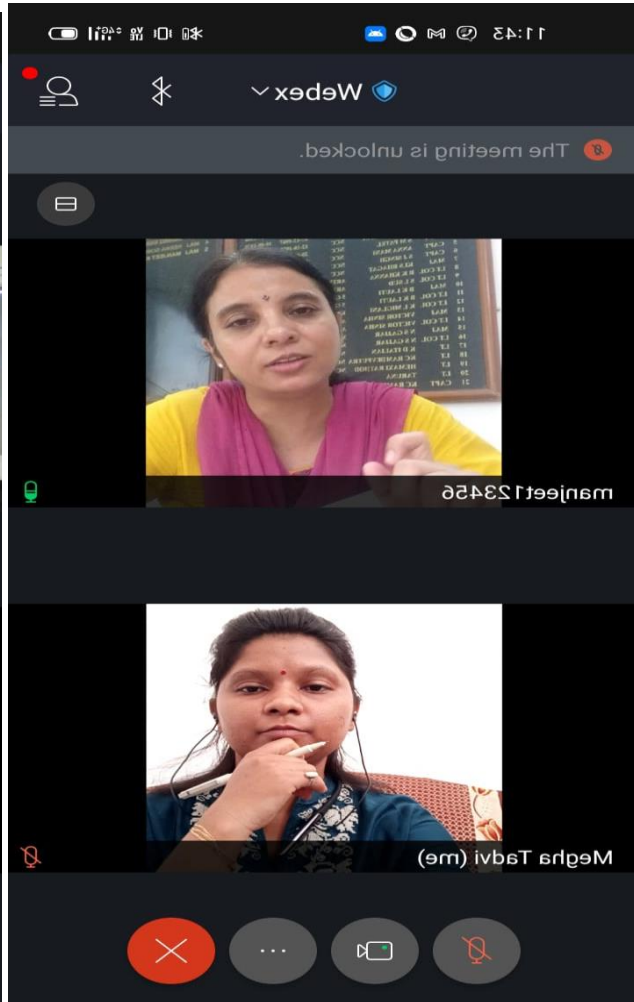
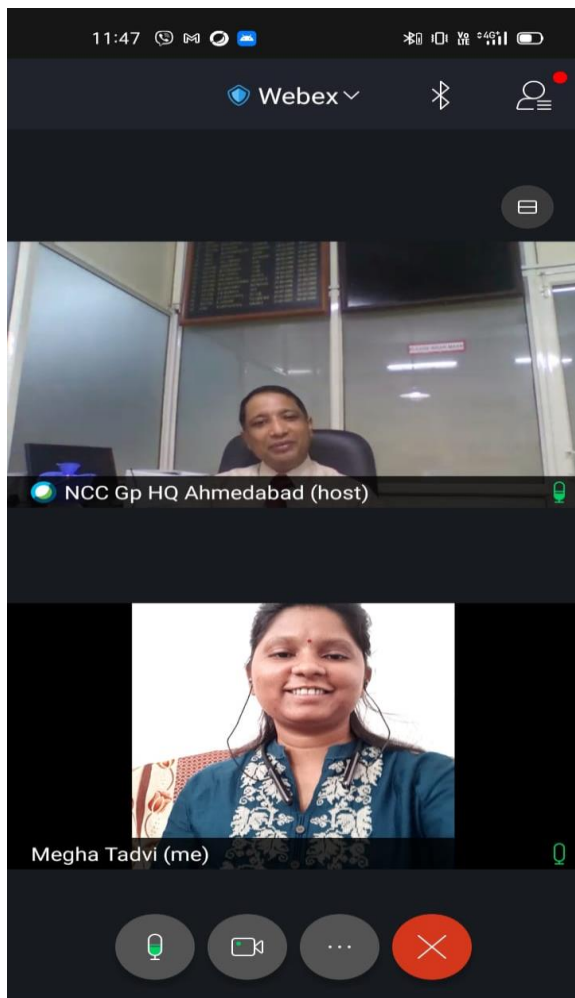


## 54. CELEBRATION OF INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY
