
2. International Yoga Day Celebration (21st June 2017)


4. Swachh Bharat Abhiyan Campus cleaning (November 2017)

6. SWACHH BHARAT ABHIYAAN

In 2018 May, the Government of India launched the 'Swachh Bharat Abhiyaan' throughout the nation. All the educational institutions and NCC groups across India were given instructions and guidelines to conduct a 'Swachh Bharat Summer Internship'. As a part of the project the NCC Cadets of IITE also carried out the project in various phases as follows:





7. Planning and Preparation for the 'Abhiyaan'

Discussions and planning as to how the whole project will be carried out, which village can be adopted to carry out and spread the 'Swachh Bharat' campaign were carried out initially.

All 33 NCC cadets and ANO, Lt. Dr. Swarnabharati of IITE actively participated not only in the planning and preparation sessions but also carried out all the activities enthusiastically.



8. Adopting a Village – Nana Chiloda

As a part of the 'Swachh Bharat Summer Internship' the NCC cadets of IITE were required to adopt a village to spread awareness about importance of cleanliness, hygiene and sanitation. The NCC Cadets were required to spread the awareness through various activities like door to door visit to spread awareness, street play, rally, cleaning the village/village school and spreading awareness among students.

Nana Chiloda Village was selected for this purpose and we met the Sarpanch of Nana Chiloda village for permission to carry out these activities in the village over a period of a week.



9. Swachhta Awareness Rally & Door to Door Awareness Campaign

After the adoption of the village and permission from the Sarpanch, a rally was carried out through the Nana Chiloda village by the NCC cadets, shouting slogans on 'Swachh Bharat' and importance of cleanliness, sanitation and hygiene. After carrying out the rally, the NCC cadets divided themselves into groups and spread out in all directions in the village to spread awareness by approaching every house and talking to the members of family available, especially women.





10. Cleanliness Drive

As per the permission and guidelines granted by the Sarpanch of Nana Chiloda village, a primary school in the heart of the village was chosen for the cleanliness drive. The IITE NCC Cadets cleaned up the Primary school premises in the presence of the students and teachers. 
18. Successful Completion of 'B' & 'C' Certificate Examinations (2018)








20. The Cadet Gujarat Magazine (2018)










24. ANO's Conclave (March 2019)


26. International Yoga Day Celebration (21st June 2019)

Kargil Divas is celebrated in IITE, Gandhinagar to commemorate the martyrdom of brave soldiers who sacrificed their lives for the nation.






31. Visit by the Commanding Officer (July 2019)

33. National Thal Sainik Camp (September 2019)

TSC is a national level competition camp. Competition is conducted in the following NCC Subjects:

- 1. Health & Hygiene
- 2. Line Area & Tent Pitching
- 3. Map Reading
- 4. Rifle Shooting
- 5. Obstacle Course
- 6. Judging Distance & Field Craft

Only 32 Senior Wing girl cadets are selected from all over the Gujarat Directorate. The cadets have to undergo numerous training and selection camps before facing the Inter Group Competition (IGC) Camp in which the final cadets are selected who would be competing at the national level, Delhi.

11 NCC cadets of IITE, Gandhinagar were selected initially, on the basis of personal interview conducting by the Commanding Officer and the Administrative Officer, for a series of TSC training and selection camps held at the 1 Gujarat Girls Battalion NCC Headquarters, Law Garden, Ahmedabad. Further, 5 cadets were shortlisted to participate in another series of TSC IGC Camps conducted at Thamna, Vallabh Vidyanagar, Anand. The 5 cadets were:

In a series of IGC training-cum-competition camps, Cdt. Pooja Maheshwari & Cdt. Itika Rathod, both competing for Best Cadet, were awarded with a gold and silver medal respectively, for scoring the highest marks in the written examination.

34. Piping Ceremony of Cadets (Rank Ceremony) (October 2019)
















66. CATC CAMP ATTENDED BY CADETS
